The scheduling of these will be organised by the Chief Umpire or Polo Manager. If asked each team must provide a fully tacked and bandaged umpire pony, warmed up and presented to the side lines no later than 15 mins before the start of their games.

Please note: If any team member is playing in any other tournament(s), the team captain must notify the Polo Manager ASAP. If a team member is unable to play, it's the teams responsibility to find a substitute player.
